

Rev. Dr. Carolyn McCall-Livingston

Reverend Carolyn McCall announced her call to preach the gospel of Jesus Christ in 1994; she was certified and licensed by the Texas Annual Conference as a local pastor in 1995. In May 2001, she was ordained as an Elder in full connection of the Texas Annual Conference.

Her pastoral appointments began in 1995 in Conroe, Texas for two years. She served as Associate Pastor at Spring Woods UMC, then a two-point charge at Cypress UMC as an Associate Pastor and Senior Pastor at Mallalieu, then appointed to Atascocita UMC in 2001 until 2008. She has served as a motivational and spiritual development speaker for Women's Ministries in and around the Houston Area and the Golden Triangle. She also enjoys Mission Outreach. Her mission outreach has allowed her to travel to Belize, Jamaica, Zimbabwe, Africa, the Philippines, and the Holy Land for various mission and educational experiences.
